SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF RICHMOND, KENTUCKY

- 1. Applicants must be participating communicant members of the First Presbyterian Church of Richmond. Example:
 - Do you regularly attend Sunday worship services and/or Sunday school?
 - Are you actively involved in the Youth Group, the music ministry, childcare, etc.?
 - If you are attending college away from Richmond, do you attend Sunday worship when you return to Richmond for weekends or holidays? Do you regularly attend Sunday worship or participate in church-related activities in your college town or city?
- 2. Individual awards each year will depend upon the funds available and the number of eligible applicants.
- 3. Priority in awarding scholarships will be as follows:
 - Graduate students enrolled in programs leading to full-time Christian service,
 - First-time undergraduate students,
 - Continuing undergraduates.
- 4. All applicants must submit a cover sheet including demographic information to include name, permanent address, current address, and phone contact. Also include the institution or institutions to which he/she has been admitted.
- 5. All applicants will write a one-page, double-spaced statement describing:
 - (a) your <u>active participation</u> in the life of the Richmond First Presbyterian Church or in the life of a church in the town or city where you attend college;
 - (b) what you hope to achieve in life.
- 6. All applicants will submit a copy of their most recent transcript and a written statement describing their academic plans for the upcoming year (courses to be taken, major [if chosen], etc.).
- 7. In all matters the Scholarship Committee shall have final discretion in the interpretation of guidelines and in the awarding of scholarships.
- 8. Applications of students planning to enroll in the fall semester <u>must</u> be submitted by Monday, July 16, 2012, at 3:00 pm.
- 9. In order to assure that your application is considered, please carefully follow the guidelines.
